It will expand your knowledge from one-word signing to sentences... Get ready to feel comfortable talking about topics from greetings to emergencies, daily living, and special occasions while using the basics of ASL. Experience deaf culture first hand by meeting and communicating with members of the Deaf community. The cost for the class is \$25.00 per adult. Class fees are waived for Hand-N-Hand families.
