PROGRAMS & SUPPORT

DEAF & HARD OF HEARING PLAYGROUPS –

A fun and educational environment where deaf and hard of hearing children and their families have full access to communication through visual, auditory, and/or tactile communication systems.

PARENT & COMMUNITY EDUCATION –

Discover a broad range of perspectives on hearing loss and related issues, and learn sign language.

PARENT -N-PARENT NETWORKING –

Networking opportunities empowering and stimulating the family's growth and development.

MUSIC-N-MOTION – Music & movement for infants, toddlers and preschoolers who have hearing or speech differences ... and the grown-ups who love them!
