Deaf & Hard of Hearing (DHH) Playgroup

DHH PLAYGROUP meets weekly and offers children ages birth to five who are deaf and hard of hearing, their parents, families, and caregivers the opportunity to have fun and learn in a friendly environment that promotes language, early literacy, and social & emotional development.

DHH Playgroup is open to families who have children with a hearing difference and/or communication delays, infant to age 5. Family members are welcome.

* Total Communication (TC) is a philosophy of educating children with hearing loss that incorporates all means of communication; formal signs, natural gestures, fingerspelling, body language, listening, lipreading and speech.

ROOTS-N-WINGS meets weekly and teaches children sign language through games, stories & activities, highlighted with D/HH community interaction. Participants learn basic roots of sign language with opportunities to spread their wings and feel comfortable using the language.

RNW is open to HNH families/children ages 6-12yrs.; special circumstances may apply. Class size is limited, minimum enrollment required; cost is \$30.00/PP.
