Deaf & Hard of Hearing (DHH) Playgroup

DHH PLAYGROUP meets weekly and offers children ages birth to five who are deaf and hard of hearing, their parents, families, and caregivers the opportunity to have fun and learn in a friendly environment that promotes language, early literacy, and social & emotional development. DHH Playgroup includes group activities, peer-to-peer socialization, art & snack.

DHH Playgroup is open to families who have children with a hearing difference and/or communication delays, infant to age 5. Family members are welcome.

* Total Communication (TC) is a philosophy of educating children with hearing loss that incorporates all means of communication; formal signs, natural gestures, fingerspelling, body language, listening, lipreading and speech.
